## *Care Instructions*

### **CARING FOR MAHOGANY WOOD**

Gently wipe the wood with a clean, soft cloth, which has been slightly dampened in plain water.

Our premium Mahogany timber has been sealed – therefore requires no oil, wax or polish – using such products may alter or damage the finish.

Avoid cleaning the wood with chemicals, detergents, hand sanitizers or any non-approved products, as it may be harmful to the finish, and may cause discoloration or other damage.

Avoid any form of close contact to artificial heat.

Avoid placing wood in excessive sunlight or UV glare, as it may cause the wood to discolour or crack.

## *Care Instructions*

### **CARING FOR FULL GRAIN LEATHER**

Gently wipe the leather occasionally with a clean, soft cloth, which has been very slightly dampened. When using any leather cleaner or conditioning product – always test a small and discrete area first, and allow settling for at least 24 hours. Inspect the cleaned area for any potential damage or fading before applying the conditioning product to the entire leather product. Professional cleaning is recommended. Avoid contact or cleaning leather with any chemicals, detergents, hand sanitizers, alcohol based or non-approved products, as it may be harmful to the finish, and may cause discoloration or other damage. Avoid any form of close contact to artificial heat. Avoid placing leather in direct sunlight or consistent UV glare, as it may cause the leather to discolour, fade or crack. .

## *Care Instructions*

### **CARING FOR MARBLE**

Gently wipe marble with a clean, soft cloth, which has been dampened in a diluted mixture of dish soap (eg; Sunlight liquid). Marble is a porous stone, and is more susceptible to stains compared to other natural or engineered stone. Take care not to mess or spill substances, which has a higher stain rate, as it may be difficult to clean or remove the stain completely. Always clean marble immediately after mess or spillage. Avoid cleaning marble with chemicals or non-approved products, as it may be harmful to the finish, and may cause discoloration or other damage.

## *Care Instructions*

### **CARING FOR FABRIC**

Gently brush the fabric with a soft, clean, dry brush. Please ensure that the brush used is as soft as possible – as an aggressive brush may damage the fabric. For any other cleaning requirements, please make use of a professional cleaning service. Avoid cleaning fabric with chemicals or non-approved products, as it may be harmful to the fabric, and may cause discoloration or other damage. Avoid placing fabric in excessive sunlight or bright glare, as it may cause the fabric to discolour or cause other damage.
